## 2011 VETTE FEST SHOW-N-SHINE

-Rules updated 7/23/11

**Welcome Participants** to the Vette Fest Show-n-Shine competition. We are excited this year to present a new format for the 2011 Show-n-Shine event. We have adopted official Corvette car show judging criteria that some of you may be familiar with. Participant cars will be judged by independent judges based on the rules listed below. Awards will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in C1, C2, C3, C4, C5 & C6 classes. There's a special class just for Z06's, ZR1's, ZR-1's and Grand Sports. The 2011 award winners will truly reflect automobiles that have been meticulously prepared for the show. The Show-n-Shine will take place at the new Barbacoa restaurant on Parkcenter Blvd in east Boise. You will love this festive location with a Boise City Park and pond behind Barbacoa.

In addition we will also have a group of show awards that you can compete for including People's Choice, Sponsorship Favorites, Charity Selections and others. ### Participant Rules

1. The participant vehicle must be registered in accordance with the laws of the state in which the license plate it carries. The vehicle must be capable of being legally driven on the streets and highways, excluding race vehicles.
2. It is recommended participants remove all loose non essential items within the vehicle. This includes items in the storage compartments. Registrations, insurance, legal documentation, owner's manual, T-top covers, seat covers and other original vehicle equipment may remain in the vehicle during judging.

3. The condition of the convertible top and roof panels are included in the judging criteria. It is asked that roadsters should be shown with their tops up at least during the judging. T-top models and coupes should also be shown with the roof panels in place. To do otherwise could cause you the loss of points.
4. Judges will be independent of Valley Corvettes members to remove conflicts of interest. It is asked that you do not talk or hold up any of the judges. They have over 115 cars to judge.
5. Please don't have elaborate displays or reader boards. Your car is the only thing being judged. Displays are not part of the judging and can distract the judges and cause them to miss a judging area and cause you to lose points.
6. The inspection areas to be judged will include:
  - a. Interior Styling and Appearance
  - b. Exterior Color and Appearance
  - c. Engine Compartment Appearance
7. Please look for participant entry signs on Parkcenter Blvd when driving your Corvette into the Barbacoa parking areas. There will be parking attendants helping you to locate a parking space. Keep an eye out for them.
8. After parking your vehicle; you are welcome to put the finishing touches on your Corvette until the Judges stop by your car. Judges are inspecting vehicles for cleanliness, style, color combinations, and strict attention to detail. Judges may ask questions about your car so please be available when they are around your car.
9. We want to point out that as the judges are judging your car you should be available to open doors, close hoods, and trunks for them to properly judge your Beautiful Corvette. Please have your windows, tops and hoods up while judging is taking place. After Judging you can roll windows and tops down.
10. Please refrain from talking to the judges while they're judging your car unless a question is asked. You may distract the judges and cause him to miss an inspection area and cause you the loss of points.
11. The judges were asked not to touch your car w/o your permission. In the event a judge or anyone else should leave a fingerprint mark on your vehicle that has not been judged, you may wipe that area down with a clean cloth. In the event the wind is blowing and debris and/or dust blows in or on your vehicle the judges will be instructed to overlook this situation.

\*\*Each participant can have his/her judging score sheets returned if requested to the Show-n-Shine coordinator after all the final tabulations are completely finished on all vehicles.

**Disqualification Criteria:**

1. Any participant willfully interfering or trying to influence the decisions of the judges may be disqualified.
2. Any participant that exhibits obvious unsportsman or arguementive like conduct during any phase of the Show-n-Shine event may be disqualified from the event.
